



## COMMUNITY HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION

What is hazardous waste? It includes any material that poses a threat to human health or the environment. **There will be a free hazardous waste collection day hosted by the Town of Fort Frances on September 14th from 9am-3pm at their Public Works building on Fifth Street West.** It is open to all residents of the Rainy River District. If you have any of the items listed below please keep them for proper disposal this coming September. The community will be collecting the items prior to the event and bringing them in on your behalf.

### ITEMS CONSIDERED HAZARDOUS INCLUDE:

- **PAINT**
- **OLD GAS/DIESEL FUEL**
- **SOLVENTS**  
such as paint thinners
- **MOTOR OIL AND OIL FILTERS**
- **KITCHEN/BATHROOM CLEANERS**
- **THERMOMETERS CONTAINING MERCURY**
- **ANTIFREEZE**
- **BATTERIES**  
from AAA to car sized
- **AEROSOL CANS**  
spray paint, hairspray, bug spray, cleaners, etc.
- **LIGHT BULBS AND FLUORESCENT TUBES**
- **MAKEUP, PERFUME, COLOGNE**
- **NAIL POLISH, HAND SANITIZER**
- **PROPANE CYLINDERS**  
from old bbq's & fire extinguishers
